Book E., page 249, fronting 50 feet on the south side of Goodrich Street with a depth  
in parallel lines of 203.5 feet along its eastern side and along its western side of  
198.6 feet and being 50.24 feet wide at rear, being the same conveyed to me by *Pride &
