all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville, on the North side of East Stone Avenue in the Block East of Elizabeth Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point 109 feet from East Elizabeth Street and running thence along Stone Avenue 54 1/2 feet to a stake, Peace's corner; thence along joint lines of lots #15 and 17, 206 1/2 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Stone Ave. 54 1/2 feet to a stake; thence in a southerly direction 206 1/2 feet to the beginning corner.
