Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

*Situate about 2 1/2 miles from the City of Greenville on the National Highway and being a part a part of the Cole Spring Farm and containing approximately four acres, more or less and being a portion of tract No. 3 according to plat made by P. E. Dalton, Eng. Feb. 1921, having a frontage on the National Highway of 284.8 feet, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the centre of a concrete Culvert on the National Highway and running thence S. 19.07 E. 467 feet to a pipe on the Boling property and corner of Tract No. 2; thence S. 86.10 W. 100 feet to a spring; thence S. 12-31 E-26.36 E to iron pin; thence S. 8.51 E. 238 feet to an iron pin, corner of said Boling property; thence in a straight line N. 89.34 W. about 81 feet to an iron pin in the line of J. D. Bridges property, formerly the E. S. Griffing land, thence N. 72.29 E. 225 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72 E. 29.5 feet to a stone; thence N. 24.20 W. 48.5 feet to a Maple; thence S. 75.20 W. 92 feet to a pin; thence N. 31.30 W. 328 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 33.35 W. 43 feet to an iron pin on the National Highway; thence with said National Highway N. 58.57 E. 134.8 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said Highway N. 63.16 E. 150 feet to the beginning point.
