 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto me A. E. Waldens

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Batesdale
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 1/2 acre of land, about 1/2 mile from the Greenville
 County Courthouse, having the following lines and bounds, to wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin at a concrete bridge on said Burrowes Road and running thence
 with said road N. 72° 45' W. 400 ft. to a stone; thence N. 30 E. 200 ft. to a pine;
 thence S. 31 E. 400 ft. to a stone; thence N. 30 E. 200 ft. to black
 locust on North Fork River; thence with said River in a southwesterly direction S. 30°
 E. 300 ft.; thence N. 11 W. 40 ch.; thence N. 5° E. 6.50 chs. to an iron pin on Burrowes Road;
 thence N. 32° E. 37 chs. to a stone; thence N. 75 E. 6.50 chs. to a pine; thence S. 74°
 E. 40.50 chs. to a stone on a branch; thence with said branch to the beginning corner.
 Containing 1/2 acre, less a tract of five acres, however here conveyed by Ed. Ward
 to S. A. and Velilla Purvis by deed dated Dec. 29, 1921 recd recorded in Vol. 74, page
 228. Said tract being the same tract conveyed to me this day by Ed. Ward by deed of even
 date heretofore.

In the boundary above described there is a tract of three acres more or less, on which
 there is now situated North Fork Batesdale Baptist Church as will appear by reference to deed
 recorded in Vol. 74, page 228, and it is not intended by this deed to convey any portion
 of said tract.
