all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Near the City of Greenville, in City View, known as lots nos. 111 and 112 on plat of City View recorded in Plat Book 9,
pages 460 and 461, each of said lots having a frontage
on the east side of 3rd Street Avenue of fifty feet, with
a depth in parallel lines to a ten foot alley of one
hundred and fifty feet. Being the same conveyed to
me by James Hobie on the 1st day of June 1922.
