Gilbreathall that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Katie A.D.

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

containing twenty eight acres more or less, beginning at a stake on the Penncombe Road and running N. 32° E. 9.50 to a stake; thence N. 50 E. 14.15 to a stake in branch; thence along the meanders of the branch 26.50 to an iron post fixed in branch; thence S. 23 1/4 E. 15.25 to an iron post; thence S. 38 W. 10.00 to an iron post in the Penncombe Road; thence along the Penncombe Road 6.23 to the beginning corner having such fence and share as will appear by reference to a plat made by W.
