being situate in the State and County above named on the head waters of South Tiger River, adjoining lands of David Cannon, Seaborn Brown, John Ward's Estate and others, containing sixty-three (63) acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to us by E. Inman, Master by deed of even date herewith, the same not yet recorded.
