released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Julia S. Charles Attorney
all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the city of Greenville, on the South side of Oscar Street, beginning at an iron pin 150 feet from the West side of Bailey Street and running thence with Oscar Street N. 54-15 W. 50 feet to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Newton Terry; thence with his line S. 50 W. 125 feet to an iron pin thence S. 54-15 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot of Andrew Long, thence with his line N. 30 E. 125 feet to the beginning corner.
