all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On the corner of West Greenville on the extension of Pendleton
Street, or Pendleton Road, commencing at a point twenty (20)
feet, on said road from the right of way of the Southern
Railway; thence in a westerly direction on a line
approximately parallel to the Southern Railway one
hundred forty (140) feet to a point; thence in a southerly
direction along a line parallel to said Pendleton Street;
or Pendleton Road thirty (30) feet thence in an easterly direction
along a line approximately parallel to said Southern
Railway to a point on said Pendleton Street or Pendleton
Road one hundred forty (140) feet; thence to the beginning
corner thirty (30) feet, this being the same lot of land
