Pinson's lot on the north side of said road or street and running thence N. $9\frac{3}{4}$ E. 210 feet to stake $3\frac{1}{2}$ on James A. Finlay's line; thence with said line N. $80\frac{1}{4}$ W. 104 feet to a stake $3\frac{1}{2}$ J. C.
