and if unpaid when due to bear interest as aforesaid as principal until paid, and have further

promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the principal sum for attorney's fees if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any

kind, reference being hereunto as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said J.J. Aiken

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better

securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. S.E. Campbell

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known

as Lot No. 145 on plat of City View, made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor, recorded in R.I.C. Office

for Greenville for said County in Plat Book "A", page 460, and described as follows,

according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on a new cut road at intersection of Hunt Street, and running thence

along the cut road in an easterly direction 124 feet to corner of lot No. 147; thence in

a westerly direction along line of lot No. 147, 116 feet to Hunt Street; thence along Hunt

Street in a southerly direction 53 feet to the beginning. Being the same lot of land

conveyed to me by G.T. Hammond by deed dated December 31, 1919, and recorded in R.I.C.
