Greenville, being Lot No. 5 of the property of C.C. Hindman as shown on plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, December 1919, recorded in Plat Book E, page 187, and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on East Court Street 55 feet from the east side of ten foot alley; thence with line of said Street S. 71-39 E. 25 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 6; thence with line of said lot S. 18-21 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on 11 foot Alley; thence N. 71-39 W. with said alley to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 4; thence with line of said lot N. 18-21 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
