in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.T. Jones

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Butler

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following acres and bounds, according to a

survey and plat made by R.E. Delton, Engineer, March 1921, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in a road, and running thence with the line of the property of C.C. Hindman S. 69-55 W. 556.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 45-50 W. 243 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 61-20 W. 662 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 61-20 W. 61.50 W. 842.5 feet to pin; thence N. 69-30 E. 213.5 feet to pipe; thence N. 69-20 E. 1447.7 feet to pipe, corner of J.A.
