with interest from January 1, 1923

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at the Southwest corner of Hudson and Meadow Streets and

described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the south bank of the old bed or run of Reedy River at Hudson Street, and running thence with said Street W. 22-30 E. 8.19 to Meadow Street; thence along the south side of Meadow Street N. 54-15 W. 5.69, more or less, to line of lot of Miss Bettie Whitnair; thence with her line S. 37-1/2 W. 4.86, more or less, to an iron pin on South side of said Reedy River old bed or run; thence along the edge of said old bed or run S. 33 E. 8.21, more or less, to the beginning corner.
