SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said B. N. Grammell

in and by my American certain promissory note in writing of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Twenty Three Hundred

DOLLARS,

to be paid on or before the date when the first Series of the Capital Stock of the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if I fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the Constitution and By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being hereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said B. N. Grammell

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me,

the said B. N. Grammell in hand well and truly paid by the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said GREENVILLE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the north side of Hamilton Avenue, usually known and designated as Lot No. 15, on a plat of the property of W. T. Mills, recorded in Plat Book C, page 223, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Hamilton Avenue at the corner of Lot No. 14, which point is sixty (60) feet in an east-ward direction from the northeast corner of the intersection of Hamilton Avenue and Calhoun Street, and running thence with Hamilton Avenue S. 73° 45' C. sixty (60) feet to a stake on the corner of lot No. 16, thence with the line of Lot No. 16, N. 16° 15' C. one hundred seventy five (175) feet to a stake on a fifteen foot alley, thence with the line of said alley N. 3° 13' W. sixty (60) feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 17, thence with the line of Lot No. 14 S. 16° 13' W. one hundred, seventy-five (175) feet to the beginning, being the same lot conveyed by W. T. Mills, June 15th 1921 and recorded in St. Rec. C. Office, Vol. 71, page 348.
