Beginning at a point on the north side of Stone Avenue and run thence n. 73° w. 54 1/2 feet to a stake (southeast corner of lot 23); thence north line of said lot n. 73° w. 206 1/2 feet to a stake, common corner of lots 25, 26 and 23; thence with line of lot 25 S. 73° E. 54 1/2 feet to a stake on a new street, thence S. 17° W. 206 1/2 feet to the beginning corner being known as lot no. 24 of the Stone Sands, according to plat recorded in Vol. "VV" page 544, and being the same conveyed to me by R.
