THIS INDENTURE, made this 22nd day of Oct A. D. 1921

by and between Olive A. Peace

party of the first part, and the MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two thousand no. 00

00 Dollars loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, S. C., the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Near the City of Greenville, at the east side of Rutherford Road beginning at the southeast corner of Rutherford Road and Mountain View Avenue, thence along said Avenue S. 64-30 E. 100 feet to corner, thence along line parallel with Rutherford Road S. 28-15 W. 189 1/2 feet to a stake thence N. 64-30 W. 100 feet to Rutherford Road thence with Rutherford Road N. 28-15 E. 189 1/2 feet to the beginning corner being one of the lots conveyed to me W. D. Parrish and J. C. Gower by deed dated March 7, 1917, and recorded in Book 36 page 184. Also that lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, known as a part of the Buist property and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on Mountain View Avenue joint corners of lots nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with said Avenue 100 feet to stake, joint corners of lots nos. 2 and 3 thence in a southerly direction along the line of lot no. 3, 189 1/2 feet to stake, thence in a westerly direction 100 feet to a stake joint corner of lots nos. 1 and 2 thence along line of lot no. 1, 189 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, being known as lot no. 2 and including that portion of an alley shown on plat made by W. D. Gower dated June 1, 1911 and showing lot above described being the same conveyed to me by W. D. Parrish and J. C. Gower by deed dated March 12, 1918 and recorded in Book 42 page 368.
