Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second

part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

all of that lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of the James Feiley lot on Spring Street, thence with said Spring Street N. 21 E. 66.8 feet to corner of Louise H. Mc David's lot said corner being at corner or Southedge of Sweet Walkway, at rear of apartment building, thence with said line S. 69 E. 55.8 feet to a stake on iron pin on Louise H. David's line formerly owned by Mrs. M. O. Patterson, thence with said line S. 22 07' W. 46.7 feet to an iron pin at corner of Louise H. Mc David's and C. O. Allen's lot, thence S. 20.49 W. 20.5 feet to an old stump corner of James Feiley lot thence with line of said lot N. 68 30 W. 56.5 feet to the beginning corner and Spring Street and being the same lot land conveyed to me by Louise H.
