Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

C. for Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 334 to 345, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Vannoy Street corner of lot no. 10 as shown on said plat and running thence with line of lot no. 10 N. 71.50 W. 192 feet and seven inches to stake, corner of lot no. 11; thence with line of lot no. 11 S. 20.19 W. 55 feet to stake, corner of lot # 14; thence with line of lot # 14 S. 71.50 E. 192 feet and seven inches to stake on Vannoy Street; thence with said Vannoy Street N. 20.19 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner.
