THIS INDENTURE, made this 7th day of October A. D. 1922

by and between George M. Moore and Prudence Moore, both of the County and State aforesaid

party of the first part, and the MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Thirteen Hundred Dollars (\$1300.00)

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part are anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and for further consideration of one dollar to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina containing one-half acre, more or less, and about 2½ miles west of Greenville Court House on the north side of Cedar Lane Road Main street, and having the following lines and bounds Viz: Beginning at a stake 34 on said road and corner of Lot 7 and running thence N. 9½ E. 210 feet to a stake 34 on back line; thence along said line S. 80½ E. 105 feet to a stake 34 corner of Lot 9; thence S. 9½ W. 210 feet to a stake 34 on said street or road; thence along north side of street N. 80½ W. 105 feet to the beginning corner being known as Lot No. 8 in the late division of the Findley land and bounded by Lots 7 and 9 of lands of said Findley on Main street or Cedar Lane Road and being the same lot of land conveyed to George M. Moore and Prudence Moore by M. P. Springfield and others by deed dated July 15 1921 and Recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 69, page 284.
