WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Fifty-three hundred

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

On the south side of Earle Street in the City of Greenville, known as Lot F of Map 4 on plat of lands of Mt. City Land and Improvement Co., said plat being recorded in R.M.C. Office in Volume WW, page 605. Said lot is more fully described as follows:  
Beginning at a stake on the South side of Earle Street at the corner of lot G, and running thence with Earle Street S. 84-1/2 E. 65-1/2 feet to a stake on said Street at the corner of lot E; thence with line of lot E, S. 5-1/2 W. 134-1/2 feet to a stake at the corner of lot I; thence with line of lot I, N. 84-1/2 W. 65 feet to the corner of lot G; thence with line of Lot G, N. 5-1/2 E. 134-1/2 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same conveyed to me by Eliza H. McGee by deed dated May 10, 1922, recorded in Book 74, page 394.
