the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second

the city and County of Greenville in the state of South
Carolina, on the south side of Webster Street and having
the following lines and boundaries: Beginning at an iron
at a rock wall at the corner of Nathan Salter's lot
thence running east along said Webster Street fifty feet
and eleven inches to a fence; thence south along said
fence one hundred two feet and three inches to a
dividing fence between lot belonging to Randy Weston,
bought from Butler and McBruleough; thence along said
fence fifty-one feet to a fence dividing the property
of Nathan Salter and this property; thence north along
said fence one hundred and one feet and six inches
to the beginning corner, containing five thousand one
hundred and fifty-one (5151) sq. ft. more or less,
