whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Rush, his heirs and assigns, All that lot of land situate in ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Elford Street 186 feet west from the intersection of Elford and Main Streets and runs thence along Elford Street N. 62-33 W. 38.2 feet to an iron pin, Hoke corner; thence along line of Hoke property S. 27.11 W. 100 feet, more or less, to stake; thence S. 60-51 E. 41.2 feet to stake corner of Lot No. 2; thence with line of that lot N. 25.28 E. 100.6 feet to the beginning corner, being known as lot No. 3 as shown on plat recorded in plat Book E., page 47.
