set out in note which this mortgage secures) with interest thereon from date (subject to provision) at the rate of 4 1/2 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of the amount due

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); and in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and his successors, heirs and assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in my office County, State aforesaid,

All that undivided one-fifth part of the lot situate in and to, All that certain lot of land situated, lying and being on the southwest corner of Main and Washington Streets, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of lot now or formerly owned by J. W. Davis on Main Street, and running thence up Main Street 105 and 7/10ths feet to Washington Street, thence with Washington Street 120 feet, 5 inches to corner of lot formerly known as "Warehouse lot", thence 105 and 7/10ths feet to corner of lot now or formerly owned by J. W. Davis, thence with said Davis's line 120 feet, 5 inches to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that this mortgage is junior in lien to the mortgage executed by Caroline L. Howland, et al, to New York Life Insurance Company, in the principal sum of \$42,000.00, dated December 13, 1935, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of mortgages "64" at Page 306, and is equal in priority with two similar mortgages in the sum of \$2,000.00 this date executed by me, one to Caroline L. Howland and the other to Mary S. Mauldin, and is executed in compliance with and subject to provisions of Deed contained in Judgment Roll E-5424.
