

**Davidson County, North Carolina**  
**Compressor Station No. 0155 — Additional Lands**

That certain tract of land conveyed to the Company by Deed from Hugh J. Roberson, et al, dated May 28, 1969, recorded in the Deed Records of Davidson County, North Carolina, in Book 474, Page 84, conveying a tract of land situate in Reedy Creek Township, County of Davidson, State of North Carolina, and bounded as follows: BEGINNING at a stake in Warner Road and corner to Sowers heirs, and running thence with their line North 19 degrees 30' West 455 feet to a stone, their other corner; thence with their line South 85 degrees 20' West 512 feet to an iron stake, their other corner; thence North 12 degrees 30' West 264 feet to a stone; thence North 85 degrees West 264 feet to a stone; thence North 83 degrees West 244 feet to a stake; thence with Byerly's line North 13 degrees West 387 feet to a stake in branch; thence North 89 degrees West 26.4 feet to a stake at branch; thence South 12 degrees East 198 feet to a stake; thence South 19 degrees 30' East 198 feet to a stone, Byerly's corner; thence with Byerly and Warner's line South 12 degrees East 1,878 feet to a stake in the Warner Road, Warner's corner; thence with the Warner Road North 81 degrees East 470 feet to a stake in the road; thence North 47 degrees 40' East 657 feet to the beginning, containing 20 acres. **Rockingham County, North Carolina**  
**Compressor Station No. 0160 — Additional Land**

That certain lot or parcel of land conveyed to the Company by Deed from Franklin D. Dunn, et al, dated September 23, 1969, recorded in the Deed Records of Rockingham County, North Carolina, in Book 666, Page 99, conveying a tract or parcel of land in the County of Rockingham, State of North Carolina, and bounded as follows: Beginning at a cross mark (X) on a road in the old abandoned "Eagle Falls" of New Bethel-Wentworth Road said point being George Carter's corner with Gladys Sharp Wilson, in the former W. O. Carter line and running thence along the said old road, with the Carter line, South 30 degrees 25 minutes West 255.7 feet to a stake near a Triple Poplar tree at the corner of the field, a corner for the said W. O. Carter land, thence a new line with George Carter, North 85 degrees 25 minutes West, 102.3 feet to a point in the present hard-surfaced New Bethel-Wentworth or Winston-Salem Road (State Route #65) said point being 30.4 feet from a stake in line on the east side thereof, thence along the middle of said
