All that certain tract or parcel of land conveyed to the Company by Ashwill Corp., by deed dated August 21, 1969, and recorded in Middlesex County Clerk's Office in Deed Book 2671, Page 161, hereinafter particularly described, situate, lying and being in the Townships of South and North Brunswick, in the County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the line dividing property formerly of Rubin Ayres, more recently of Olivia King and now of Johnson and Johnson distant along said line 918.09 feet from its intersection with the Southerly line of New Jersey State Highway U. S. #1 as now located, said beginning point being also the end of the fifth course as described in the second tract in the deed conveying property from Ashwill Corp., to Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation dated Oct. 3, 1968 and recorded in the Middlesex County Clerk's Office in Book 2637 at Page 309 and from said beginning point running thence (1) South 21 degrees 13 minutes 13 seconds East 1913.36 feet along property now of Johnson & Johnson to an old stone monument; thence (2) South 21 degrees 13 minutes East 763 feet more or less still along property now of Johnson & Johnson to the center of Oakey's Brook; thence (3) Southwesterly down the center of Oakey's Brook 90 feet more or less to a point on a line parallel and distant Westerly 75 feet, as measured at right angles, from the second course as described above; thence (4) North 21 degrees 13 minutes West 840 feet more or less along the line parallel with the second course above mentioned to a
