All that piece or parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being in the State of South Carolina, in the
County of Greenville, in the
First Ward of the City of Greenville, on the northeast
corner of the intersection of Hampton Avenue
and Biggs Avenue, and having the following
metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake
on the northeast corner of the intersection of
Hampton Avenue and Biggs Avenue and running
thence along the north side of Hampton Avenue
3.32 E. 115 1/2 feet to a stake on corner of J. R. -
Owen's lot; thence with Owen's line N. 05 E. 166
feet to a stake; thence N. 32 W. 115 1/2 feet to a
stake on Biggs Avenue, thence with Biggs Avenue
as the line 166 feet to the beginning corner on
Hampton Avenue.
