interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole and to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note other providing for an attorney's fee of ten dollars per cent

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
