We, George Wright and Mitty Wright-Phillips SEND GREETING:  
WHEREAS, we, the said George Wright and Mitty Wright-Phillips  
in and by their certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, and are well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars  
Dollars, to be paid

with interest thereon from Map N. Goodlett at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of Twenty Five Dollars  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said George Wright and Mitty Wright-Phillips  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Map N. Goodlett

Map N. Goodlett all that lot or parcel of land situate lying  
and being in the State and County aforesaid about one and  
one fourth miles from the Greenville County Court House  
and beginning at a R. O. Stump on the north side N. 61 E. 1.75'  
to a stake, thence S. 1 E. 3.00 chs. to stake; thence S. 61 W. 1.75'  
chs. to a stake; thence N. 1 W. 3 chs. to the beginning corner,  
containing one-half of an acre, more or less.

Less however, a certain lot by Mitty Wright to her daughter  
Lidia Wright who has, since said conveyance, died intestate  
leaving a husband, Wesley Foster, she never having any children  
it is the intention of the grantors to mortgage their interest  
in said lot to the grantee herein.
