WHEREAS, I, the said Z. E. Thackston
in and by a certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Seventy One Hundred Seventy-one + 707.100
Dollars, to be paid November 1st 1921

with interest thereon from 1st day of May 1921 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten Per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Z. E. Thackston
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Bank of Simpsonville
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said

Z. E. Thackston
in hand well and truly paid by the said Bank of Simpsonville

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Simpsonville and its successors and assigns

All that certain piece or lot of land lying and being on the road running west from
Simpsonville, and beginning at a pin in center of road; thence S. 20-1/2 E. 4.73 chains to
center of branch; thence down said branch as line S. 75 W. 2.22 to pin; thence N. 20-1/2 W.
4.30 to pin in road; thence along said road N. 65 E. 2.22 to beginning corner and containing
One acre, more or less;

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land beginning in center of road West of
Simpsonville Cotton Mills and on Cotton Mill line and running S.W. with cotton mill line
to center of branch 3x; thence with meanderings of branch down to Z.E. Thackston's line
3x; thence with Z.E. Thackston line north to center of road leading through cotton mill
village 3x; thence up said road to the beginning corner and containing Six acres, more
or less, and bounded on the East side by Simpsonville Cotton Mills on south by Louise G.-
Burdett and on the west by Z.E. Thackston and on the North by road leading through
Simpsonville Cotton Mill Village, also

that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County,
West of Simpsonville, S.C. and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning
in center of road in front of F.A. Jordans residence 3x; thence S. 17-1/4 E. 3.93 chains
to branch 3x; thence N. 69 E. 3.50 chains up branch as a line to Stake 3x; thence N. 20-1/2
W. 4.20 chains to center of road a stone or iron pin 3x; thence S. 65 W. 3.28 chains along
