I, George W. Williams SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said George W. Williams
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

L.B. Morrison
in the full and just sum of Two hundred (\$200.00)
Dollars, to be paid on December 15th, 1921

with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said George W. Williams
in consideration of the said sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

L.B. Morrison
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
George W. Williams

in hand well and truly paid by the said
L.B. Morrison

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L.B. Morrison, "All that lot of land in the County and State

aforesaid about two and one-half miles west of Greenville Court House, known as Lot
#3, according to plat made by H.Olin Jones for M.D. Earle April 16th, 1914, said lot has
the following metes and bounds: Beginning in a road at corner of lots conveyed to Peter-
White by M.D. Earle, running thence with the road S. 13-11 E. 65.5 feet to corner of lot
conveyed to M.D. Earle to Diana McDowell; thence S. 76 W. 419.4 feet to line of Graceland
Cemetery lands; thence N. 14-37 W. 66 feet to corner of said Peter White's lot; thence
with Peter McWhite's line N. 76-03 W. 42 feet to beginning corner. This being a part
of the tract of land of two and one-half acres conveyed to M.D. Earle and Elias Earle,
February 23rd, 1910 by Richard A. Earle dead recorded in Vol. 5, page 775, in R.M.C.
Office Greenville County, S.C. The interest of Elias Earle having been subsequently devised
to M.D. Earle by him. See his will on file in Probate Court, recorded at Apartment 103
File #4, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me By M.D. Earle, see R.M.C. Book 44,
page 520.
