grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.W. Poole, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

lying and being in the Town of Simpsonville, S.C. on the Southwest side of the
Simpsonville Cotton Mill side track, having the following notes and bounds:-
Beginning at a stake ten feet south from the center of said side track on Mrs. Lillie
Black's line 3x; thence along said line 20 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction
230 feet to center of Old Stage Road on the line of Lot #2, 3x; thence up said Stage
Road in a northerly direction 80 feet to a stake 10 ft. from the center of the side track
3x; thence in an easterly direction 230 ft. to the beginning corner and known as Lot #1;
