Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$100.00 dollars on the first of each
and every month hereafter until the Two thousand two hundred and fifty (\$2,250.00)
be paid in full.

with interest thereon from date of date of said payments at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid quarterly
until said debt is full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

one dollar besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by a attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said note and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof of the said

Joseph R. Bryson

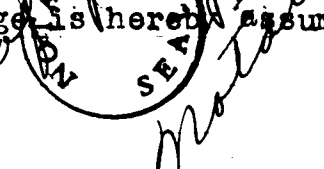
in hand well and truly paid by the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto me, D.J. Goodwin and Otis Jamison, all that piece, parcel

or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and County
aforesaid, on the East side of Rowley Street, fronting on said Street fifty-five (55)
feet and running back therefrom in parallel lines to a depth of one hundred ninety-two
and 7/10 (192.7) feet, the same being known and designated as lot number fifteen (15)
Section H., of the Stone Land Company property as shown on plat made by J. B. Sirrine,
May 21, 1909 recorded in Plat Book A, pages 337 to 345, in the office of the R.M.C. for
the State and County aforesaid.

This being the same property as conveyed to me this day by the said D.J. Goodwin and
Otis Jamison, this mortgage being given to secure a part of the purchase price.
This mortgage is second and junior in lien to the lien of a certain mortgage given by
the said D.J. Goodwin and Otis Jamison to J.H. Roe, Administrator and Nancy W. Roe,
Administratrix of the Estate of J. Haskeil Roe, dated June 16, 1921, and recorded in the
office of the said R.M.C. for the State and County aforesaid in Mortgage Book 97, page
54, given to secure the payment of \$4000.00 due and payable one year from the date
thereof, but which has been extended by agreement, and made due and payable three years
from the date thereof, the payment of which mortgage is hereby assumed by me.
