County of Greenville and just outside the limits of the
city of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds
to wit:

Beginning at a stake on Monaghan Avenue and running back
two hundred and six (206) feet to a stake, thence north
sixty six (66) feet to a stake on Canal Street; thence west with said
Street two hundred and six (206) feet to a stake, thence south
along Monaghan Ave, sixty six (66) feet to the beginning corner,
This being lot number 26 of the estate of D. P. Verner, according
to a plat made by W. M. A. Hudson, November 28, 1904.
