interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of seven percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

of Lot No. 5 - Block D. of Buist Circle, according to a plat recorded in the  
P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, page 10, and having  
the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a point 5-10 feet  
from Rutherford Street on the south side of Buist Avenue and running  
thence with said Buist Avenue S. 65° E. 50 feet; thence S. 25° W. 125 feet  
thence N. 65° W. 50 feet; thence N. 25° E. 165 feet to the beginning corner,
