WHEREAS, I, Arthur S. Agnew, the said Arthur S. Agnew
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of ninety Hundred Dollars
Dollars, to be paid August 29th 1922

with interest thereon from August 3rd 1921 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Brownlee

All that certain, piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid near City View, being a portion of the old Goldsmith & Agnew Farms containing 19.4 acres more or less, beginning on Long Branch at corner of Lot # 8 in the survey of said Goldsmith & Agnew Farms and running thence N. 36.10° E. 256 feet to corner; thence N 20.35° E. 1200 feet to road, thence along said road 424 feet to corner of said road; thence S 47.15° W. 1225 feet to Long Branch, thence down said branch 78 feet to the beginning corner and being known and designated on said survey of the Goldsmith & Agnew Farms as Lot # 7 and being known as my homeplace.
It is understood and agreed that this is a second mortgage upon the said tract of land, there being a \$2500 mortgage prior to this.
