WHEREAS, I, the said Julia C. Robertson

Dollars, to be paid on or before the 1st day of November 1921

with interest thereon from the 1st day of November 1920 at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid quarterly in arrears

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent. (10%)

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Norwood

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in the Fourth Ward of the City of Greenville, on the south side of East McBee Avenue, being a portion of the land conveyed by W. C. Cleveland to J. W. Norwood by deed dated June 28, 1911, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Volume 12, page 99-100, and conveyed to Fannie C. Norwood by the said J. W. Norwood by deed dated March 30, 1921, and conveyed by Fannie C. Norwood to me by deed dated April 2, 1921, recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 71, page 425; and more fully described, as follows:
Beginning at a stake on the south side of East McBee Avenue, the northwest corner of a lot conveyed by W. C. Cleveland to Mrs. Louise McBee Williams thence southward along the line of Mrs. Williams' lot 151 feet to a stake; thence westward in a line parallel to and 151 feet from the line of McBee Avenue 66 feet to a stake; thence northward 151 feet to a stake on the south side of McBee Avenue thence eastward with the line of McBee Avenue 60 feet to the beginning corner.
This being Lot no. 1 on plat of property of J. W. Norwood recorded in plat book E, page 583.
