interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

Town of Fountain Inn, County and State aforesaid, containing .59 acres, more or less,
and being all that remains of a tract of land conveyed to me by deed recorded in the

being all of that said parcel except that conveyed away by me to B.R. Edwards, by
deed dated Jan. 27, 1919, recorded in office of R.M.C. for said County in book 34 at
