SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Thomas Long
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

C. A. Fraser of Greenville, S.C.
in the full and just sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date of July 1943 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of fifty dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Thomas Long, for and

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. A. Fraser

All that piece, parcel or lot of land being known as lot #14 of Block B, of the sub-division known as Sterling Annex, and being located just beyond and south of the City limits of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid; plat of the same being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County in Vol. E., of plats, at page 141. The description of the said lot is as follows: Beginning at a wooden peg on the south side of Sterling Street 200 feet from the southwest corner of Sterling and Maloy Streets; thence with Sterling Street N. 23-10 W. fifty feet to the northeast corner of lot #15; thence with lot #15 S. 67-0 W. 157.83 feet to a point (being a common corner of lots 15, 7, 6 and 14); thence with line of lot #6, S. 23-30 E. fifty feet to a point (being common corner of lots 6, 5, 13 and 14); thence with line of lot #13, N. 67-0 E. 157.77 feet to the point of beginning on Sterling Street.
