computed and paid semi-annually
until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Williamston, All my right, title and interest,

the same being an undivided three-seventh interest, in and to all that certain piece,
parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville on the South
side of Pendleton St. near its intersection with Augusta St. Beginning at an iron pin at
the corner of K.S. Conrad's and running thence S. 69 W. with Pendleton St. 49 feet to a
stake; thence S. 22 E. 68 feet to a stake; thence N. 69 E 53 feet to a stake in Conrad's
line; thence with Conrad's line in a northwesterly direction 68 feet to the beginning corner.
Being my interest in the same lot conveyed to H.B. Bates, Trustee for the benefit of
himself, R.L. Cruikshanks, J.M. Richardson, W.A. Wallace, Frank R. Henry, J.C. Martin and
John C. Henry by deed dated Oct. 6th, 1919 by J.E. Payne, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Vol. 53 at page 203, and by deed R.L. Acree conveying same to me Oct.
31st, 1921. Also by deed J.C. Harper conveying same to me on October 31st, 1921.
