I V. C. Drummond SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said V. C. Drummond
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

G. W. Bridwell
in the full and just sum of Eight hundred, eighty eight + 39/100
Dollars, to be paid 300.00 on January 1, 1922 & 300.00 on January 1st,
1923, and \$ 288.39 payable on January 1, 1924

with interest thereon from date made at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. W. Bridwell

all that certain tract of land in the County and State
aforesaid containing 50 acres more or less, with the following
metes and bounds Beginning at a stake on Beaverdam Creek
at corner of J. H. Bridwell thence S. 25 1/2 W. 5.45 to paper
thence S. 41 E. 29.58 to pine stake thence along line con-
veyed to J. H. Bridwell N. 80 1/3 E. 15.50 to stone at corner,
thence N. 15 1/4 W. 11.20 to white oak thence N. 7 1/2 E. 20.00
to stake on beaverdam creek thence up the meanders
of said creek to the beginning corner and being the
land conveyed to me by G. W. Bridwell by deed dated
May 6, 1919, recorded in the office of T. M. C. for
Greenville County in Book 34 at page 569.
This mortgage is junior to a mortgage executed to the
Federal Land Bank of Columbia on the day of October
