interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof. If the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release into the said Norwood National Bank of Greenville, S. C.

all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land in
the County and State aforesaid, about seven miles south
east of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated
as tract no. 1 of the J. S. Hauley estate, and containing 2.2
acres more or less. Beginning at an iron pin on line
of D. J. Miller's lands, and running thence N. 64 W. 7.40
to P. O. thence S. 6 W. 35.70 to P. O. corner Tract no. 4, thence
along line of tract no. 7, N. 61 7/4 E. 8.73 to iron corner of
tract no. 2, thence along line of tract no. 2 N. 6 E. 28.00
to the beginning corner being the same lands conveyed
to me as Flarrice C. Hauley by C. Sumner Master, indeed
