with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Anna Cureton for and
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said
Peoples National Bank, Greenville, S.C.
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
Anna Cureton
in hand well and truly paid by the said

Peoples Natl Bank
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank Greenville, S.C. its

successors or assigns, all my right title and interest same
being an undivided one-third interest as Widow of William
Cureton, deceased, in a tract of land in Austin Township, state
and county aforesaid containing 58 acres more or less being
a part of the lands partitioned in the case of Maria Gold-
smith et al v. Elizabeth A. Ferrell, and being the same tract
of land conveyed by J.B. Hayne to Aaron Walker and William
Cureton by deed dated Jan. 7th 1891 and recorded in R. M. C.
Office for said county in Book XX page 373; the interest of
Aaron Walker was conveyed to William Cureton by deed dated
17th day of Nov. 1896 recorded in R. M. C. Office for said county
in Book C.C.C. Page 604, said William Cureton having died
September of 1911.
