until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Piedmont, its successors and assigns, All that certain

piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, State and  
County aforesaid, adjoining lands of Walter Campbell, O.H. Garrison, Capp Campbell and  
others, containing One hundred acres, more or less, and being a portion of that same  
tract of land containing one hundred, twenty-three acres, more or less, conveyed to me by  
M.B. Cureton by deed dated February 4th, 1890 and recorded in office of R.M.C. for  
Greenville County, in Book VV at page 628, the remaining twenty-three acres, having been  
sold and conveyed to O.H. Garrison.
