with interest thereon from date at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-monthly

under said note, and interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon for the purpose of this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent on said
amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Susan C. Gallivan

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being
in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, fronting fifty-
three and three tenths feet on Cedar Avenue and running back to
an alley and designated as Lot no. 11, Block "D D" on plat of the
Riverland Company's property made by Carter & Pringle, Surveyors,
and recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 323, and being the same
property conveyed to me by the Riverside Land Company by deed, dated
2nd day of October, A.D. 1911 and recorded in said R.M.C. office in Vol. 2
page 124. Also all that other piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying
and being on said Cedar Avenue, adjoining the above described lot
on the west, and known and designated as Lot no. 10, Block "D D" on said
Plat, and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the northern
side of Cedar Ave. corner of lot no. 9, being 175.5 feet, more or less, East of
Belt Line Ave; and running thence with line of lot no. 9, N. 10-15 E. 129 feet
to stake on an alley, thence with said alley S. 79-57 E. 50 feet to stake, corner
of lot #11, thence with line of lot no. 11 S. 10-15 W. 140.7 feet to stake on Cedar
Avenue; thence with said Cedar Ave. in a westerly direction 51.3
feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to
me by said Riverside Land Company by deed, dated the 6th day
of March, A.D. 1915, and recorded in said Register's office, in Vol.
2, at page 126.

Also, all that other certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate,
lying and being in said County and State, on Cedar Ave. and
adjoining the lot first above described on the East and known
and designated on said Plat as Lot no. 12, Block "D D" and
having a frontage of 112.8 feet on Cedar Ave. and a depth
of 204 feet on Chicago Ave, running back to an alley.
