SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Robert R. Bishop  
in and by two certain promissory note S in writing, of  
even date with these presents, was well and truly indebted to

Overbrook Land Company  
in the full and just sum of One Thousand One Hundred and fifty (\$1150)  
Dollars, to be paid on or before first payment of \$600 December 1, 1922,  
Second payment of \$300 December 1, 1923, third payment July  
1, 1924 of \$250

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Robert R. Bishop  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Overbrook Land Company  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said

Robert R. Bishop  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Overbrook Land Company

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Overbrook Land Company

All of that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land on the North side of the Spartanburg  
Road near the City of Greenville and being more particularly described as follows:  
Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of the Spartanburg Road, being the joint  
corner of lots G-6 and G-7, and running thence N. 48-32 W. 200.1 feet to an iron pin;  
thence N. 48-33 E. 25.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-19 W. 52.7 feet to an iron pin  
thence S. 48-32 E. 234.2 feet to an iron pin on the north side of the Spartanburg Road;  
thence S. 41-38 W. 73 feet to the beginning point and being designated as lot number,  
G-7, on the subdivision of the Overbrook Land Company according to survey and plat by  
H. Olin Jones September 17, 1913 and of record in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville  
County.
