may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. F. Schwing, his heirs and assigns;

as lot no. 2 on plat made by H. D. Lin Jones, for M. D. Earle,
April 16, 1914, and having the following meters and bounds
to wit: - Beginning at a pin in the road corner of lot No. 1
and running thence with said road S. 13.11 E. 54.5 feet,
thence S. 76.23 W. 421 feet to Graceland Cemetery line, thence
with Graceland Cemetery line N. 14.37 W. 55 feet to
