SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said F. L. Mayfield  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to  
The Peoples Bank of Fountain Inn  
in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred twenty-five  
Dollars, to be paid December 15, 1922

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually  
until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, which I hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto The Peoples Bank of Fountain Inn

All that certain three parcel and lot of land lying, and  
being situate in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid,  
on the waters of Horse Pen Creek, containing  
in the aggregate 83 acres more or less, and being

and a portion of a 28.33 acre tract conveyed to me by  
F. M. Bourdette by deed dated December 19, 1919, recorded in  
the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 55 at  
page 112 it being the intention of this obligation to cover  
and include all of the balance owned by me of the  
said three tracts of land which aggregate 83 acres more  
or less and being the entire lands conveyed to me by  
deed of F. M. Bourdette, except 9.02 acres which I have conveyed  
to C. E. Mayfield by my deed dated Dec. 21, 1921.
