WHEREAS, I, J.C. Bright, the said J.C. Bright

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R.E. Rollins, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of

land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Chick Springs Township
and being a part of the Louise M. Cottongham and Nanie M. Zimmerman Estate and known and
designated as lot No. 6 on a plat recorded in Plat Book E., page 135 and being more
particular described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north side of 19th, Street S.W. Corner of lot No. 5 and runs
thence with said Street N. 88-35 W. 100 feet to iron pipe corner of Hensons lot; thence
along Hensons line N. 16.55 W. 145 feet to iron pipe S.W. corner of lot No. 7; thence
along line of lot No. 7, N. 65.15 E. 50.2 feet to corner of Vaughans lot; thence along
