I Nellie K. Hinman SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Nellie K. Hinman

may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Bank of Piedmont

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Piedmont, its successors

and assigns:  
All that certain piece or lot of land, situated, in Grove  
Township, State and County aforesaid, containing One (1)  
acre, more or less, adjoining lands of J. C. Anderson  
and Joe Garrison, and being the same lot conveyed  
to me this day by Mrs Orva Anderson, and not yet  
recorded.

shall secure any renewal of said note.
